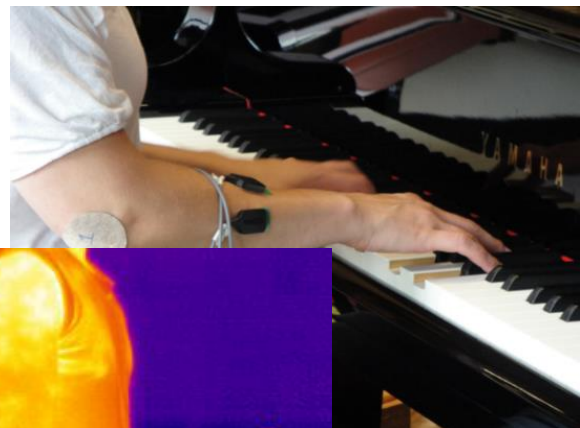

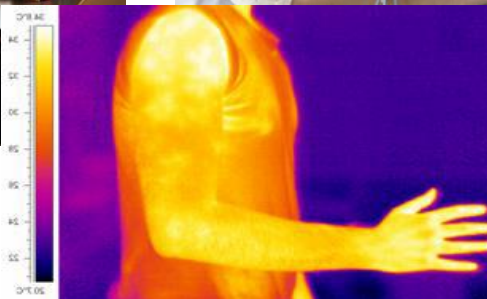
### **Musicians' Wellness Centre.**
